



Severe Weather and School Closure Policy

If the weather conditions are, in the opinion of the Headteacher, sufficiently severe to warrant the closure of the school before the commencement of the morning session, or the school has to close for another reason e.g. failure of the heating system or most staff are unable to travel, then the following procedure will be put in place:

The Headteacher will, after having gained permission from the Chair of Governors, inform the Local Authority by TXTRound that the school will close. This will inform transport and radio stations too. The Headteacher will then inform staff and parents via our communication system – Parent Hub.

Staff will inform the Headteacher by 7:15 am if they are unable to travel to school. The Headteacher will then decide if there are enough staff to be able to open the school. The Headteacher will then inform staff and parents by text.

NB: If the Headteacher is absent, a member of the Senior Leadership Team will perform these duties, keeping the Headteacher informed if possible.

Review

This policy was agreed the FGB in May 2026. It will be reviewed in May 2028 or before if necessary.
